

ORDINANCE NO. 37-00

An Ordinance to appropriate \$8,000.00 from the unencumbered Street Fund for the purpose of supplying and installing the necessary electrical equipment to provide underground electrical service to all four quadrants of Drexel Circle.

WHEREAS, the Broad Street Signalization and Street Lighting Project removes all existing overhead wiring from Broad Street and places it underground, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide electrical service to all four quadrants of Drexel Circle, **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the amount of \$8,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Street Fund for the purpose of supplying and installing the necessary electrical equipment to provide underground electrical service to all four quadrants of Drexel Circle.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
