ORDINANCE NO. $\mathcal{H}/$ -00

An Ordinance to amend Section 1264.12 of the Planning and Zoning Code to increase the membership of the Board of Zoning Appeals from five regular members to seven regular members.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section `1264.12 is hereby amended as follows:

There is hereby established a Board of Zoning Appeals which shall consist of seven regular members and two alternate members appointed by the Mayor and approved by Council. The Mayor with the approval of Council shall choose a successor to fill any vacancies. Each regular member shall serve a term of five years, except that one of the members appointed in 2000 shall serve a four year term. The alternate members shall be appointed from the ranks of former members of the Board and shall serve for a period of two years. The alternate members shall serve only during the absence of a regular member. One member only of the Planning Commission may be appointed to the Board of Zoning Appeals. The Board shall adopt rules necessary to the conduct of its affairs and in keeping with the provisions of the Zoning Code.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the effective date of Amended Ordinance No. 7-00, which in no case shall be earlier than the earliest period allowed by law.
