

ORDINANCE NO. 44-00By: Jed Morison:

An ordinance to appropriate \$20,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund, \$5,000.00 from the unencumbered Refuse Fund, \$18,000.00 from the unencumbered Street Fund and \$2,000.00 from the unencumbered Recreation Fund for the purpose of purchasing gasoline.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$20,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as follows:

Section 2. That \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Refuse Fund as follows:
