

ORDINANCE 50-00

An Ordinance to reappropriate the amount of \$2,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the Community Awareness of Substance Abuse (CASA) for services rendered to the City of Bexley in the year 1999.

WHEREAS, the amount of \$2,000.00 was appropriated in the 1999 budget to pay for services provided by CASA, and

WHEREAS, CASA did not bill the City for the services in a timely manner, causing the funds to lapse.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$2,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying CASA for services provided in the year 1999.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
