An Ordinance to appropriate \$5,000.00 from the unencumbered Refuse Fund for the purpose of purchasing 1,000 curbside recycling containers for sale to residents who wish to participate in the City of Bexley's curbside recycling program and to declare an emergency.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**


Section 1. That the amount of \$5,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing 1000 curbside recycling containers for sale to residents who wish to participate in the City of Bexley's curbside recycling program.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, said emergency being the necessity to place the order by June 28, 2000, to coincide with a manufacturers production run and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
