An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,500.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of entering into a contract with ~~The Davy Tree Expert Company~~ for the purpose of providing watering services to the newly planted London Plane trees on Main Street and declaring an emergency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the amount of \$2,500.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for contract watering services for newly planted London Plane trees on Main Street.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purpose of providing contract water services.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, safety and welfare, said emergency being the need to provide the trees with water from July through September to insure their survival and shall take effect immediately upon its signing by Mayor.
