

ORDINANCE NO. 79-00

An Ordinance to appropriate \$15,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of supplementing the Building Department Contract professional account to provide professional building inspection services through the year 2000 and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, \$60,000.00 was appropriated for inspection services, and

WHEREAS, the cost for those services has exceeded that amount due to significant increase in construction projects, which increased the number of inspections required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$15,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of paying for services needed through the rest of the year 2000.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, the emergency being the need to pay for inspections performed and to provide inspection services for the year 2000.


