An Ordinance to amend Bexley Code Section 1040.03 regarding replacement of water meters and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Bexley Code Section 1040.03 should be and hereby is amended as follows:

1040.03 REPLACEMENT OF OBSOLETE METERS.

The City is authorized to replace all obsolete meters of the size of three fourths of an inch or less. If it is necessary to replace any obsolete meters over three fourths of an inch, the property owner will be required to pay the difference between the cost of a three fourths inch meter and the meter so replaced. require the replacement of any meters determined to be obsolete, damaged, inaccurate or incompatible with the City's metering system. The cost of the replacement shall be charged to the customer or as otherwise provided for by City Council.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, said emergency being the need to install an automated meter reading system beginning October 30, 2000, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
