## ORDINANCE NO. <u>93</u>-00

An Ordinance to appropriate \$6,666 from the Water Fund, \$6,666 from the Sewer Fund and \$6,667 from the Refuse Fund to pay health, dental, vision and life insurance costs of employees whose compensation is paid from such funds for the year 2000, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with United Health Care of Ohio providing health insurance to employees and elected and appointed officials of the City effective January 1, 2001 and to appropriate \$41,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of providing "tail coverage" in connection with the termination of the City's current health insurance contract and to declare an emergency.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That \$6,666 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund, \$6,666 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund and \$6,667 is hereby appropriated from the Refuse Fund to pay health, dental, vision and life insurance costs of employees whose compensation is paid from such funds for the year 2000.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with United Health Care of Ohio providing health insurance coverage on terms previously submitted to and approved by the Finance Committee of Council, which contract provides health insurance coverage for the City's employees and elected and appointed officials effective January 1, 2001.

Section 3. That \$41,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the premium for "tail coverage" in connection with the termination of the City's current health insurance coverage.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide uninterrupted health insurance coverage for employees and elected and appointed officials of the City, and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
