

RESOLUTION NO. 1-01

A Resolution authorizing the Police Department to hire one police applicant in order to have the applicant enrolled in the Police Academy Class scheduled to begin on March 5, 2001, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Council has previously established the approved staffing level of the Police Department at 28 sworn officers;

and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is anticipating one vacancy due to retirement, and the next Police Academy Class will not convene until September 2001, and this Council has determined that it is in the public interest to maintain the Police Department at 28 sworn officers ;
NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That, in order to avoid working with staff shortages for an extended period of time, the Police Department is hereby authorized to hire one police officer applicant, in excess of the approved staffing level of 28 sworn personnel. This approval is for the specific purpose of placing this applicant in the Police Academy Class that is scheduled to begin on March 5, 2001, and does not alter the previously approved staffing level of 28 sworn personnel.

Section 2. That this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to maintain the Department at its authorized staffing level at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
