

ORDINANCE NO. 11 -01

An Ordinance to authorize the purchase of materials for maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year 2001.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase and delivery of approximately the following materials for the maintenance and repair of various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley for the balance of the year 2001, to wit:

- Bituminous Concrete 150 tons
- Cement Concrete 350 cubic yards

Section 2. That the amount of \$25,000 has been appropriated and set aside from the Street Construction, Repair and Maintenance Fund, Account Number 03-380-133, in Ordinance No. 63-97 for the purchase of bituminous concrete and that said contract, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 2. That the amount of \$8,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the Street Repair, Operating Supplies Fund, Account Number 03-387-132, in Ordinance No. 63-97 for the purchase of cement concrete and that the contract, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
