

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -01

An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,100.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of funding the purchase of asphalt for the re-location of the skateboard park and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$3,100.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of funding the purchase of asphalt for the re-location of the skateboard park.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to relocate the skateboard park. This Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
