An ordinance to appropriate \$19,986.76 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for police overtime associated with the continuation of the Juvenile Task Force.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That subject to the receipt of confirmation that the grant continuation has been approved, \$19,986.76 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General fund as follows:
