

ORDINANCE NO. 27 -01

An ordinance to appropriate \$208,373 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for Mobile Computers, Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) Hardware and Software, Records Management System Hardware and Software and Automated Booking Hardware and Software.

WHEREAS, the City desires to maximize the efficiency and community policing efforts of its police officers; and,

WHEREAS, the existing police computer aided dispatch and records management system has exceeded its capacity and useful life expectancy; and,

WHEREAS, the Bexley Police Department has requested funding through the COPS MORE Technology Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley will provide the 25% match. NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That subject to the receipt of confirmation that the grant application has been approved, \$208,373 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as follows:

\$156,280 (75%) reimbursable grant amount  
\$52,093 (25%) City's match for grant  
\$208,373 Total Grant Award

Section 2. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
