An Ordinance to appropriate \$20,000.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to Account #1385551435 for the purpose of paying costs associated with the installation of the traffic signal at the intersection of Gould Road and East Broad Street.

Whereas, the installation of the traffic signal at the intersection of Gould and Broad was a cooperative effort between the City of Bexley and the City of Columbus, and

Whereas, the City of Columbus reimbursed the City of Bexley \$20,000.00 for costs that it incurred, and

Whereas, the \$20,000.00 was deposited into the unencumbered Capital improvements Fund and must now be appropriated for the purpose of paying the costs incurred by Bexley. **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the amount of \$20,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to account #1385551435 for the purpose of paying costs associated with the installation of the traffic signal at the intersection of Gould and Broad.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
