An Ordinance to impose a moratorium on the issuance of driveway permits that are requested for the purpose of installing a circular drive in the required front yard in any R-1, R-2, R-3, R-6, R-12, or R-24 Zoning District and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. Except as approved by City Council, no applications shall be accepted and no driveway permits shall be issued with respect to circular drives in required front yards in any R-1, R-2, R-3, R-6, R-12, R-24 Zoning District.

Section 2. That the moratorium established pursuant to Section 1 shall be in effect until December 31, 2001.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to regulate circular drives located in the required front yards in residential zoning districts pending Council's review of possible changes to Chapter 1256 of the Planning and Zoning code, and shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
