

ORDINANCE NO. 40-01

An ordinance to reduce the appropriation for the Special Assessments Fund by \$90,000.

Whereas there will be no sidewalk program and therefore, no sidewalk assessment revenue will be received during the summer of 2001 due to staff changes in the Service Department and,

Whereas the amount of appropriation for any particular fund must not exceed the estimated total available in that fund as reported on the City's final Amended Certificate from Franklin County,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That the amount of appropriation for account # 08-810-51190, Special Assessments Fund Operating Expenses, is hereby reduced from \$100,000 to \$10,000.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
