

**ORDINANCE NO. 53-01**

An Ordinance to appropriate \$7,500.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring Allied Roofing, Inc., to repair the roofs on the Police Department and the Maintenance Garage and to declare an emergency.

**Whereas,** the roofs on the Police Department and Maintenance Garage are leaking, and

**Whereas,** it is necessary to repair them until a determination is made regarding the potential relocation of the City buildings, and

**Whereas,** Allied Roofing gave the best bid for the work.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the amount of \$7,500.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring Allied Roofing, Inc., to repair the roofs on the Police Department and Maintenance Garage.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to prevent leaking of rainwater into the buildings, and shall go into force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
