An Ordinance to appropriate \$10,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of planting trees on Broad Street from Alum Creek on the west to Gould Road on the east.

**Whereas**, City Council commends the Tree and Public Gardens Commission for their efforts which resulted in the planting of trees on Main Street, Roosevelt Avenue and Drexel Avenue, and

**Whereas**, the Bexley Tree and Public Gardens Commission has committed to raising \$75,000.00 for the planting of trees on East Broad Street and beautifications of Drexel Circle, and

**Whereas**, City Council supports and applauds the plan for Broad Street and Drexel Circle. **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the amount of \$10,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of planting trees on Broad Street.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
