BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$ 7,600.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing two (2) traffic signal poles at the corner of Fair Avenue and Cassady Road.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
