

ORDINANCE NO. 63-01

An Ordinance to appropriate \$24,615.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying various fees and expenses incurred in connection with the possible redevelopment of the City Hall site.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$24,615.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the following fees and expenses incurred by the City in connection with the possible redevelopment of the City Hall site: \$13,630.00 to The Coral Company for reimbursement of expenses under the letter of intent between the City and The Coral Company, \$2,585.00 to Horne & King Architects for additional planning services regarding the possible relocation of City operations and \$8,400.00 to Bricker & Eckler LLP for legal services as bond counsel in connection with financing of the project.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
