An Ordinance to appropriate \$10,000 from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing fire hydrants and to declare an emergency.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO**

Section 1. That the amount of \$10,000 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered water Fund for the purpose of purchasing fire hydrants

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to replace hydrants that are out of service, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
