

ORDINANCE NO. 66-01

An ordinance to appropriate \$10,000 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to provide for trees planted on Roosevelt Avenue as a part of the 2000 street program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That \$10,000 is appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvement Fund to account # 13-855-51438 to provide for trees planted on Roosevelt Avenue as a part of the 2000 street program.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. This Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
