An ordinance to appropriate \$5,600.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for the replacement of two hot water circulating pumps and for the repair of one heat pump, this equipment being an integral part of the HVAC in Jeffrey Mansion, and to declare an emergency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$5,600.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to account number 01-540-51330 for the purpose of replacing and repairing equipment related to the functioning of the HVAC system in Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to provide heat to Jeffrey Mansion, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
