

ORDINANCE NO. 8-02

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor to pay over and contribute the proceeds, if any, from the sale of the StreeTreemendous, a software program for the care and tracking of trees developed for the City primarily through the efforts of community volunteers, to the Bexley Beautification Fund of The Columbus Foundation.

WHEREAS, the City through the efforts of members of the City Technology Commission and Tree and Public Gardens Commission, particularly William Minckler, have developed for, and contributed to, the City StreeTreemendous, a software program for the care and tracking of trees for use by the City; and

WHEREAS, StreeTreemendous is suitable for use by other public agencies and may have the potential for commercial exploitation; and

WHEREAS, since StreeTreemendous was developed with private resources, it is appropriate to use any proceeds generated by the sale of StreeTreemendous to support beautification programs in the City and, if practicable, to build an endowment for such purposes through the Bexley Beautification Fund of The Columbus Foundation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to pay over and contribute the proceeds, if any, from the sale of the StreeTreemendous, a software program for the care and tracking of trees developed for the City primarily through the efforts of community volunteers, to the Bexley Beautification Fund of The Columbus Foundation.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
