

ORDINANCE NO. 102-02

An Ordinance to appropriate \$14,950.00 for the purpose of designing a 24 inch water main along Sheridan Avenue from Mound Street to Astor Avenue, and to permit the Mayor and Auditor to sign a contract with EMH&T, the City's engineers, for the design work.

Whereas, the City of Columbus needs to construct a 24 inch water main along Sheridan Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue for the purpose of increasing pressure in their water system; and

Whereas, the City of Bexley can benefit by the construction of the proposed water line by providing an additional supply of water to the Woodsvlew and Bexley Heritage projects being constructed on Astor Avenue and future developments envisioned by the Southwest Area Plan; and

Where, the City of Columbus has agreed to accelerate the construction by one year if the City of Bexley provides the engineering design for the portion of the line from Mound Street to Astor Avenue; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$14,950.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of designing a 24 inch water main along Sheridan Avenue from Mound Street to Astor Avenue.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to sign a contract with EMH&T, the City's engineers, for the design of the water main.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
