

ORDINANCE NO. 105-02

An Ordinance to appropriate \$5,200.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying various fees and expenses in connection with the possible acquisition of undeveloped real property for a Public Service Facility.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$5,200.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the following related due diligence costs: \$4,750.00 to H.C. Nutting Company for an environmental site assessment and geotechnical/soils suitability analyses, and \$450.00 to Horne & King Architects for a preliminary site study and cost estimate, all in connection with the possible acquisition of undeveloped real property for a Public Service Facility.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
