146,214 (net of trade-in of City's existing Truck Jet) Sewer

An Ordinance to appropriate \$~~164,000~~ from the ~~unnumbered~~ General Fund for the purpose of purchasing a Sewer Equipment Company of America Model 800-HPRTV Truck Unit for the purpose of television inspection and high pressure cleaning of the City's sewer system.

Whereas, the Service Department currently has a 1991 sewer cleaning machine that requires significant maintenance including the replacement of the water tank and all pumps, and

Whereas, equipment is now available that combines sewer flushing with television inspection of sewer lines, thereby eliminating the need to hire out the inspection service when problem areas arise, and

Whereas, by having this equipment it is possible to inspect lines and correct line deficiencies prior to the development of problems, **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

\$146,214 (net of trade-in of City's existing Truck Jet) from the Sewer Fund

Section 1. That the amount of ~~\$164,000~~ should be and hereby is appropriated for the purchase of one Sewer Equipment Company of American Model 800-HPRTV Truck Unit for the purpose of television inspection and high pressure cleaning of the City's sewer system.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
