An Ordinance to appropriate \$4,500 from the unencumbered water fund for the purpose of paying for additional drinking water sampling beginning in the year 2002, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section1</u>. That the amount of \$4,500 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered water fund to pay for additional drinking water sampling, beginning in the year 2002, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to begin sampling to comply with testing requirements for the first quarter of 2002, and shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
