An Ordinance to amend Section 406.15 of the Traffic Code to authorize the Mayor to establish "limited parking" spaces on public streets for persons with disabilities and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 406.15 of the Traffic Code is hereby amended as follows:

406.15 LIMITED PARKING AREAS.

The Mayor may establish "limited parking" areas where parking to limited and no person shall park a vehicle therein in excess of the designated limit unless in compliance with the direction of a police officer and such limited parking areas shall be designated by appropriate signs to give notice thereof. **The Mayor may also establish a "limited parking" area where parking is limited to, and reserved for, the vehicle of a person with disabilities, which vehicle has been issued a disability placard or license plate by the Ohio Registrar of Motor Vehicles pursuant to Ohio R.C. 3503.44, and such limited parking area shall be designated by appropriate signs or other means to give notice thereof.**

Section 2. That Section 406.15 as presently in effect is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of providing persons with disabilities necessary special parking privileges, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


