Section 1. That the amount of \$7,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for the remodeling of the Information Systems Department office.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety and health, the emergency being the need to accommodate more personnel and equipment in the limited space and shall take effect and be in force upon its signing by the Mayor.
