

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 41 -02

An ordinance to appropriate \$10,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying salaries and wages in the Information Systems Department ,to reduce the appropriation for Police Department Salaries and Wages by \$13,600 and to reduce the appropriation for the fire contract by \$30,000.

Whereas, the position of Information Systems Manager has been added to the Information Systems Department and

Whereas, the position of Fire Inspector has been combined with Code Enforcement Officer and is now paid out of the Building Department budget and

Whereas, the appropriation level in Building Department Salaries and Wages is sufficient to cover the cost of transferring the Fire Inspector to this account. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for salaries and wages for the Information Systems Manager.

Section 2. That the appropriation for Police Department Salaries and Wages is hereby reduced by \$13,600 due to the transfer of the Fire Inspector to the Building Department.

Section 3. That the appropriation for the fire contract is hereby reduced by \$30,000.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
