ORDINANCE NO.5/-02

An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,000 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of repairing the roof on the Police Headquarters building and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the roof on the Police Headquarters Building has been repaired several times, and

Whereas, at least ten new leaks have been identified in the roof on the Police Headquarters Building in areas including the firing range, officer's work area/mail room and main hallway. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1.</u> That \$3,000 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements fund for the purpose of repairing the roof.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, said emergency being the need to repair the identified leaks to prevent further damage to the interior to the Police Headquarters building, and shall be in effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
