

**ORDINANCE NO. 55-02**

An ordinance to appropriate \$5,000 from the Court Computer Fund for the purpose of purchasing computer equipment for the Clerk of Courts office.

To appropriate \$6,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying wages for seasonal and intern employees in the Information Systems Department and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, it is necessary to add a computer workstation and replace a printer in the Clerk of Courts office, and

Whereas, the money needed for the purchases is available in the Court Computer Fund, which is entirely funded by a surcharge of court costs and fines, and

Whereas, the Information System Department has had to rely on an intern in lieu of a permanent employee for a longer period of time than expected, to accomplish its work load, and

Now Therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY**

Section 1. That \$5,000 is hereby appropriated from the Court Computer Fund for the purpose of purchasing Computer equipment for the Clerk of Courts office.

Section 2. That \$6,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying wages for seasonal and intern employees.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety and health, the emergency being the need to replace old and malfunctioning equipment and maintain current work levels and shall take effect and be in force upon its signing by the Mayor.
