

ORDINANCE NO. 56 - 02

An Ordinance to appropriate an additional \$4,500 from the unencumbered Water Fund to purchase water meters and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, a 4" compound meter with a cost of \$3,275.47 is needed to supply water to the Cassingham School complex, and

Whereas, large meters such as this are ordered on an as need basis, and

Whereas, additional meters may be needed during the year 2002, and

Whereas, the cost of the meter is reimbursed to the City in the form of purchase by the meter user. **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY OHIO,

Section 1. That the amount of \$4,500.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing meters.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and health, said emergency being the need to provide the meter to the school as soon as possible so as to not delay construction, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
