An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,400 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, Account Number 1820051320, for the purpose of purchasing seven (7) new cruiser video cameras.

Whereas, the existing cameras are aging and need to be replaced, and

Whereas, the cruiser video systems need to be maintained in optimum working order because they enhance DUI enforcement and officer safety. **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$3,400 should be and hereby is appropriated from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, Account Number 1820051320, for the purpose of purchasing seven (7) new cruiser video cameras.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, said emergency being the need to maintain properly functioning cruiser video systems, and shall be in effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
