ORDINANCE NO. 72-02

An Ordinance to amend Chapter 244, Sections 244.01(a), 244.01(b), 244.01(c), 244.01(d), 244.01(e), 244.01(f) of the Codified Ordinance of the City of Bexley to amend building permit and related review fees pertaining to construction of residential and commercial buildings upon approval of the Building Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 244 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley should be and is hereby amended as follows:

(1) <u>Building Permits</u>

- A. New one, two, or and three family houses dwellings shall be charged a minimum fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) plus ten dollars (\$10.00) per 100 square feet of portion thereof as follows: \$250.00 + .20 per square ft.
- C. For one, two, or and three family dwelling alterations and additions the fee shall be twenty-five (\$25.00) for the first five hundred(\$500.00) or portion thereof, plus twenty five (\$25.00) for the second five hundred(\$500.00) or portion thereof, plus ten dellars(\$10.00) for each additional one thousand dellars(\$1000.00) of portion thereof, based on valuation as follows:

 \$250.00 + .30 per square ft.
- D. For commercial alterations and additions the fee shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first five hundred (\$500.00) or portion thereof, plus fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the second five hundred dollars (\$500.00) of portion thereof, plus twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each additional one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) or portion thereof, based on valuation as follows: \$400.00 + .50 per square ft.
- E. For garages, carports, and auxiliary buildings accessory structures more than one hundred square feet, used in connection with a house or an apartment unit, the fee shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00) Fifty (\$50.00) for a single garage or carport, plus ten dollars (\$10.00) for each additional unit.

(4) <u>HAVC permits</u> For residential permits there shall be a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per unit. The fees for commercial per address shall be based on the total installed BTU/hour found in the following chart.

- (5) <u>Other registrations and permits.</u> The following fees shall apply for registrations and permits:
 - F. Driveway permit \$30.00 each Driveway, approach, sidewalk, curb cut, and grading permit \$40.00
 - G. Sidewalk permit -\$30.00 each Sewer permit \$200.00
 - H. Air conditioning permit \$30.00 each Ventilation permit \$20.00 per unit.
 - J. Wrecking permit \$50.00 \$100.00 each, each permit application to be accompanied by a minimum \$250.00 \$300.00 cash clean up bond.
 - K. Sign permit \$50.00 \$75.00 each
 - L. Swimming pool permit Residential \$50.00 Commercial \$100.00
 - M. Fence permit \$20.00 \$ 40.00 each
 - N. Heating permit \$30.00 each Foundation start Residential \$50.00 Commercial \$100.00
 - O. Tent permit \$100.00 each >120 sq. ft. public use only
 - Q. Excavation permit \$30.00 Building fee deposit Residential \$50.00 Commercial 10% of building permit fee.
 - R. Plan review fee Residential \$20.00 Commercial \$65.00 per
 - S. Minor alterations Residential \$75.00 Commercial \$150.00.
 - T. Re-inspection fee \$75.00.
 - U. After hours inspections \$100.00 for the first hour, \$50.00 for each additional hour minimum two hours.
 - V. Certificate of occupancy Residential \$40.00 Commercial \$80.00.
 - W. Change of use permit \$200.00.
 - X. Fire or hood suppression permit Residential \$40.00 Commercial per address \$80.00 + \$2.00 per head.
 - Y. Hood permit \$100.00 each.
 - Z. Roof, siding, windows permit \$50.00.
 - AA. Decks/porches permit \$50.00.
