

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 92 -02

An Ordinance to establish the salary of the Mayor ~~at \$ per year~~ for the four year term beginning January 1, 2004, pursuant to Section 5 of the Charter.

Whereas, the annual salary of the Mayor was established at \$73,000 for each year of the four year term beginning January 1, 2000; and

Whereas, if the Mayor's salary had, during such term, been subject to adjustment at the same rate of four percent (4%) per year granted to all employees of the City, the annual salary during such term would have been \$73,000 in 2000, \$75,950 in 2001, \$78, 957 in 2001, \$82,115 in 2002 and \$85,400 in 2003; and

Whereas, this Council believes that the compensation of the City's elected chief executive should keep pace with the compensation paid to the City's appointed executives and the compensation paid to the mayors of comparable communities in central Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the Mayor is hereby established at ~~\$ per year~~ for the term beginning January 1, 2004, as follows: 2004 - \$85,000, 2005 - \$86,000, 2006 - \$87,000 and 2007 - \$88,000.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
