An Ordinance to appropriate \$6,000.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of entering into a contract with Mass Installation, Inc. to conduct a water system study to determine unaccounted for water loss.

WHEREAS, the City's new water metering system provides accurate water consumption readings, and

WHEREAS, there is a disparity between the City water consumption readings and the amount the City of Columbus is billing. **NOW THEREFORE,**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$6,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of entering into a contract with Mass Installation, Inc. to conduct a water system study to determine unaccounted for water loss.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor should be and hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with Mass Installation, Inc.


Section 3. That this Ordinance should go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
