CITY OF BEXLEY CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATION

Grounds Maintenance Worker

Job Responsibilities:

Under general supervision, operates light motorized equipment and performs unskilled and semi-skilled labor tasks to assist with the care and maintenance of Cityowned grounds and trees; utilizes hand and power tools to maintain trees and equipment; performs other related duties as required.

Qualifications:

Any combination of training and work experience which indicates possession of the skills, knowledge and abilities listed below. An example of an acceptable qualification for this position is completion of tenth school grade and two (2) years grounds maintenance experience, or equivalent. Knowledge of applicable ANSI standards. Ability to obtain a valid State of Ohio motor vehicle operator's license and be insured by the City's insurance carrier. Ohio Department of Agriculture public operator's license desirable.

Essential Job Functions:

Operate light motorized equipment to maintain City parks and grounds (e.g. trucks, mowers, tractors, backhoe, etc.); plow snow; pick up refuse; trim trees and bushes and maintain flowers, trees and shrubs; mow and trim park beds; apply herbicides, insecticides and fertilizers.

Inspect equipment for excessive wearing of parts; perform routine maintenance on City equipment (e.g. change oil, lubricate moving parts, clean filters, sharpen blades, etc.).

Perform other unskilled and semi-skilled tasks (e.g. clean and paint buildings and equipment, mow and trim park beds, repair fences, shovel snow, spread salt, etc.).

Assist Tree Maintenance Workers with tree removal.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities Necessary to Perform Duties:

Knowledge of grounds maintenance materials, equipment and methods including plant propagation, management of perennials and annuals and fertilization, pesticide and herbicide application; safety practices and procedures; equipment maintenance.

Ability to perform heavy physical labor for extended periods of time under possibly adverse weather conditions; follow oral and written instructions; direct the work of others; work without close supervision.

Skill in operation of light motorized equipment; safe and effective use of hand and power tools.
