

ORDINANCE NO 27-03

An ordinance to appropriate \$4,000.00 from the Unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund, for the purpose of paying for the costs associated to the exploration of soil samples at Jeffrey Mansion, in relation to the collapse of the southwest retaining wall.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with EMH&T, INC. and BBC&M Engineering, INC. for boring and soil exploration near the collapsed retaining wall at Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That \$4,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose for paying costs associated to the exploration of soil samples at Jeffrey Mansion, in relation to the collapse of the southwest retaining wall.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to complete construction prior to the 2003 season, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
