<u>Section 1</u>. That the amount of \$50,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to account number 0135051190 for the purpose of paying for professional consulting, plan review and inspection services.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and health, said emergency being the need to provide these services on an ongoing basis, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
