

ORDINANCE NO. 34-03

An Ordinance to authorize the sale of certain vehicles which were formerly used as police cruisers and which are no longer needed for municipal purposes at auction to the highest and best bidder through the City of Columbus Police Department, after advertisement as required by law, to authorize the deposit of the sales proceeds, after deduction of the costs of sale, in the unencumbered General Fund, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Police Department is hereby authorized to sell certain vehicles which were formerly used as police cruisers and which are no longer needed for municipal purposes at auction to the highest and best bidder through the City of Columbus Police Department, after advertisement as required by law.

Section 2. That the sales proceeds from such vehicles, after deduction of the costs of sale, shall be deposited in the unencumbered General Fund.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to dispose of unneeded property at the earliest possible scheduled auction of the City of Columbus Police Department, and shall be effective from and after adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
