

Ordinance No. ~~45~~ 03

An Ordinance to declare a real and present emergency necessitating a contract without formal bidding and advertising pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, to appropriate \$55,000 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund ~~to the 2003 Street Project~~ to pay for the repair of the stone wall adjacent to the south parking lot at Jeffrey Mansion, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract on behalf of the City with G & G Cement without formal bidding and advertising, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the collapse of the stone wall adjacent to the south parking lot at Jeffrey Mansion has made the parking lot unusable and has created an unsafe condition; and

WHEREAS, the collapse of the wall constitutes a real and present emergency requiring prompt repair to eliminate of risk of personal injury and property damage presented by the current unsafe condition; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That repair of the stone wall adjacent to the south parking lot at Jeffrey Mansion is hereby declared a real and present emergency necessitating a contract without formal bidding and advertising pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. That \$55,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of replacement of the stone wall adjacent to the parking lot at Jeffrey Mansion.


Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City with G & G Cement without formal bidding and advertising for the project described in Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance *on the condition that such work be commenced ~~for~~ completion on or before December 31, 2003.*

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to repair the south parking lot wall at Jeffrey Mansion to eliminate the risk of personal injury or property damage presented by the current unsafe condition, and shall be in force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.


