

ORDINANCE NO. 49 - 03

An Ordinance to amend Section 262.02(d)(3) of the Administrative Code to change the benefits and terms of employment of the Health Commissioner and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 262.02(d)(3) of the Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

- (3) Health Commissioner. The Health Commissioner shall be deemed a City employee but shall not be entitled to insurance benefits except Workers' Compensation benefits at the same level that is provided to Schedule I employees. Compensation of the Health Commissioner shall be as provided by the annual pay ordinance; provided, however, that if the positions of Health Commissioner and Sanitarian are held by the same person, he or she shall only be paid the salary of the Health Commissioner.

Section 2. That Section 262.02(d)(3) of the Administrative Code as presently in effect is hereby repealed, and except as amended by this Ordinance, Section 262.02 shall remain in full force and effect without change.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to assure the uninterrupted delivery of Health Department services, and shall go into force and effect upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.


