

ORDINANCE NO. 70 -03

An Ordinance to appropriate \$15,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of trees that will be purchased under the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources Bicentennial Tree Legacy Grant Program and planted on North Cassady and Maryland Avenues, said amount to be reimbursed to the General Fund upon completion of the planting of the trees.

Whereas, the City applied for a \$15,000 matching Ohio Bicentennial Tree Legacy Grant to purchase trees to be planted on North Cassady and Maryland Avenues, and

Whereas, the Bexley Tree and Public Gardens Commission has privately funded the \$15,000 match for the grant, and

Whereas, the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources will reimburse the City's \$15,000 upon completion of the planting of the trees, NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$15,000 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of trees that will be purchased under the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources Bicentennial Tree Legacy Program and planted on North Cassady and Maryland Avenues.

Section 2. That upon completion of the tree planting and reimbursement by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources the amount will be reimbursed to the General Fund.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest date provided by law.
