

ORDINANCE NO. 83 -03

An Ordinance to amend Section 262.02(c)(19)A of the Administrative Code to increase, effective January 1, 2004, the annual payment to employees who decline group health insurance coverage to \$2,500 for family coverage and \$1,500 for individual coverage and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That Section 262.02(c)(19)A of the Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

A. Effective January 1, 2004, employees who are able to obtain health insurance coverage through a spouse or other source may choose to decline coverage under the City's group health insurance plan. Each eligible employee who is entitle to but elects to decline family coverage will receive \$2,500 per year from the City, and each eligible employee who is entitle to but elects to decline individual coverage will receive \$1,500 per year from the City. The City will make these payments in equal installments at intervals of approximately six (6) months.


Section 2. That Section 262.02(c)(19)A of the Administrative Code as presently in effect is hereby repealed, and except as amended by this Ordinance Section 262.02 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency to the need to assure comparable benefits for all employees as of January 1, 2004, and shall be in full force and effect upon passage by Council and approval of the Mayor.


