

ORDINANCE NO. 13-04

An Ordinance to appropriate \$13,400.00 from the unencumbered Street Construction and Repair Fund for the purpose of purchasing two (2) traffic signal controllers and one (1) school flasher control unit and for their installation at the intersections of Cassady and Maryland and Remington and Maryland Avenues.

Whereas, the traffic signal controllers at the intersections of Cassady and Maryland and Remington and Maryland Avenues are 1968 units that have become very unreliable; and,

Whereas, it is no longer possible to purchase parts for their repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$13,400.00 should be and hereby is appropriated for the purchase of two (2) traffic signal controllers and one (1) school flasher control unit and for their installation at the intersections of Cassady and Maryland and Remington and Maryland Avenues.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
