An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,499.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing computer software to support the "Hazard Communication Program".

Whereas, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has set various standards of safety and health in the workplace. The standard, "The Right to Know Law" is intended to cover all employees who may be exposed to hazardous chemicals under normal working conditions or where chemical emergencies could occur.

Whereas, it is necessary to maintain the MSDS Management Information System for the purpose of records retention and allowing all employees, or designated representatives to view records at all times from any city computer work station.

Whereas, this software may be utilized for supporting other programs such as GIS, Backflow, and pavement management systems. **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$1,499.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing computer software to support the Hazard Communication Program as required by OSHA.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest date provided by law.
