

ORDINANCE NO. 36-04

An Ordinance to ratify and approve agreements with the Communication Workers of America, Local 4320, with respect to the Police Radio Dispatchers and Animal and Parking Control Officers effective January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute and deliver said agreements on behalf of the City and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the agreements with the Communication Workers of America, Local 4320, with respect to the Police Radio Dispatchers and Animal and Parking Control Officers effective January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, are hereby ratified and approved in the forms presented to this Council.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on behalf of the City the agreements ratified and approved at Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to establish the terms and conditions of employment of essential personnel of the City Police Department effective January 1, 2004, and to assure the uninterrupted services of such employees, and shall be effective upon passage and approval by the Mayor
